



2017 Savage Are we there yet

Winemaker: Duncan Savage. Indicative blend: Predominantly Touriga Nacional, with Cinsault and Grenache

- This is the second highest-priced wine produced from Touriga Nacional in Western Cape. The price has been stable over the past year.
- Not quite as widely known as other wines from Western Cape. In contrast, this wine has been getting more popular over the past year.
- A diverse array of wines are made by this producer including those from grapes Sauvignon Blanc - Semillon, Shiraz, Syrah, Chenin Blanc, Pinotage, Cinsaut - Grenache - Syrah, and Cinsaut.

"Are we there yet?" is a question familiar to most parents and in this case refers to the isolation of Malgas, where Duncan Savage sources this 50/50 blend of Touriga Nacional and Syrah. Serious, sinewy and muscular with inky, meaty, black olive and damson flavours and a mixture of density and balance. 2023-30
