About the wine ...

First planted on the Estate in the 1860s, Tahbilk has the largest single holding of Marsanne worldwide including vines dating back to 1927 that are amongst the oldest in the world. Cutting the canes of the vine and allowing the fruit to hang prior to harvest concentrates the flavours and sugars to produce a luscious wine.



Since 2012 Tahbilk Winery has achieved the goal of being 'Carbon Neutral'. This means that through a transparent process of measuring emissions, reducing those emissions and offsetting residual emissions, our net calculated carbon emissions equal zero.
