



## Campbells Rutherglen Durif Limited

### Release 2018

Deep, dense red with hints of purple. An attractive bright & lifted nose with dark plum fruit at the front and hints integrated cedary oak.

Tasting notes: This medium bodied wine is easy drinking and showcases excellent balance. Sweet plum fruit comes through offering a smooth mouth feel. The Durif in the blend offers that signature grip whilst also adding dark cherry, earthy ironstone flavours.

Winemaking: Fruit was harvested early in March and fermented on skins for seven to eight days. After pressing the wine was matured for nine months in French and American oak casks before blending and bottling.

Cellaring: This wine will continue to develop over the next two to five years with careful cellaring. It's the ideal wine to share with family and friends at a BBQ or with wood fired pizza.

#### Technical:

The Grapes : Shiraz (86%), Durif (13%) and Tempranillo (1%) from our Rutherglen vineyards.
